**Sub :** Application for letter of permission for functioning of Sayali Charitable Trust College of Homoeopathy, Gut No 141,150,55, Mitmita, Nashik Road, Aurangabad, Maharastra-431002 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2025-26 - regd.

Sir,

Sayali Charitable Trust College of Homoeopathy, Gut No 141,150,55, Mitmita, Nashik Road, Aurangabad, Maharastra-431002 is functional since 2017 and has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2025-26. The college has submitted Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted inspection on 08.05.2025 & 09.05.2025, followed by hearing on 23.06.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 & 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

**1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty: (05 deficiencies)**

- i. In Department of Human Anatomy 01 Professor is deficient.
- ii. In Department of Human Physiology 01 Associate Professor is deficient.
- iii. In Department of Pathology and Microbiology 01 Associate Professor is deficient.
- iv. In Department of Surgery 01 Associate Professor is deficient.
- v. In Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology 01 Associate professor is deficient.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 05 teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college still have 01 deficiency in teaching staff. However, such relaxed teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

**2. Miscellaneous**

- i. NABL accreditation is not done.
- ii. Salary for teaching and non-teaching staff is not as per MES-2024.


**3. Considering the above observation during inspection and hearing, MARBH has decided to issue Conditional Permission to Sayali Charitable Trust College of Homoeopathy, Gut No**

**141,150,55, Mitmita, Nashik Road, Aurangabad, Maharashtra-431002 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2025-26 on the basis of following conditions:-**

- i. College should apply for NABL within one month of issue of letter.
  - ii. College should appoint 01 Professor in Department of Human Anatomy within one month of issue of letter.
  - iii. Pay scale of all the teaching staff should be according to MES- 2024 within one month of issue of letter.
4. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate (BHMS) seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT Govt. as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.
  5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
  6. Conditions under point 3 should be fulfilled within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification to the office, failing which permission for the academic year 2025-26 may be withdrawn.
